We have put together a list of frequently asked questions. Our goal is to help relieve you of any unnecessary stress and to understand how the process works best.

1. When should I set up my trial?

Your trial and rehearsal blowout should be set up as soon as you have put down your deposit to hold your date. Our summer season is extremely busy and we want to get those appointments on the book so that your spot is reserved for you. Once you have chosen your gown and have an idea of what kind of feeling you want to have, we can help with the rest. Head piece? No head piece? Up? Down? We can help you finalize your decisions. Once we know, we have plenty of time if we need to order extra hair or ornamentation.

2. How long will it take on the day of my wedding?

We use a simple formula that is very accurate. We require everyone to arrive together on the day of so that we can assess the hair and where we want to begin and how we can be efficient with an excellent end result. We take the amount of people having service and count 30 min. per person and then round up if it's on the 30. This is just to give the start time based on the time you need to walk out our door.

3. Should I wash my hair the day of?

No. The service for the bride includes a wash and blowout the night before for the rehearsal dinner. The only time we want anyone to wash their hair on the day of is if we are not putting it up, if we are blowing it dry. When the bride comes in for the day of the rehearsal, we will give you sample packets of our shampoo and conditioner for your attendants to use.

4. Can we bring food and beverages?

Absolutely. Fringe offers an intimate environment that will allow you the privacy to relax with your friends and family before the wedding. We have serving platters, champagne flutes, ice buckets and cooler. We also offer an array of refreshments...coffee, tea, espresso, latte, spring water and sparkling water.

5. Should I make a schedule for the party on the day of as to who goes when?

We appreciate the fact that you want to help, but, we've got this. As mentioned above, we would like everyone to arrive together so that we can keep it moving without any down time on our part. We may take someone out of order due to timing, etc. Also, if you are having make up done, the make up artist will be working with us through the order and timing.

6. What if I want to add more people for services the day of my wedding?

It depends on how big your party already is. It becomes a timing and staffing issue at that point. We would prefer that before you commit to a number with us, be thorough in finding out who wants to have services. Also, make sure that the number of people that you have committed to really are going to want something done. We can handle up to 13 people (that has been our largest party yet) without a problem. If you over estimate, your deposit may be bigger, however, you will have less to pay the day of the wedding.
